

Pastor's Corner

Top-Notch Education

Congratulations to our children who received their First Holy Communion this weekend!

I am grateful to our teachers who prepared them and to those of you who were present to celebrate with them and make it an even more memorable day for them. I am especially thankful to the parents who made it a priority for their children to receive the Eucharist and to be properly prepared for this momentous occasion. You are living out your role as a parent in the highest sense because you are giving your children Jesus Christ, Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity, who is the Way, the Truth, and the Life.

Joe Heschmeyer, an Apologist for Catholic Answers, wrote a brilliant article in the Fall 2023 edition of the Catholic Answers magazine entitled "The Solution to the Modern Crisis of Education." In it, he reflects on the purpose of education, citing John Dewey's progressive vision of education as what's wrong with the modern approach: "The purpose of education has always been. . . to give the young the things they need in order to develop in an orderly, sequential way into members of society." In contrast to this bland and meaningless vision, Mr. Heschmeyer cites Plato's Laws as the Catholic vision of education: To hate what ought to be hated and to love what ought to be loved. Building on Socrates, **the true goal of education is to orient the young to love the true, good, and beautiful.**

How can parents instill this love for the true, good and beautiful in their children? In paragraph 223 of the Catechism, it says that "parents have the first responsibility for the education of their children." It goes on to say that **"[p]arents should teach their children to subordinate the 'material and instinctual dimensions to interior and spiritual ones.**" My dear parents, thank you for the ways in which you make Mass and the reception of Holy Communion a priority in your lives. Thank you for modeling this to your impressionable children by the reverence and faithfulness by which you receive the Eucharist.

It is my sincere hope that each child in our parish will see how devoted we are to Jesus Christ, present in the Most Blessed Sacrament of the Altar and seeing this, may they learn to love the Eucharist as the source of all that is true, good, and beautiful.

It is my prayer that their 1st Communion isn't just a rare encounter with God, but rather a regular, weekly encounter with the source of our hope and joy, Jesus Christ.

REPORTING SUSPECTED ABUSE

If you suspect a child is being abused or neglected, make a report to the Kansas Department for Children and Families Protection Report Center by calling (800) 922-5330. Call law enforcement if the person is in immediate danger or injured. If you or someone you know has been abused by a cleric, employee, or volunteer of any archdiocesan parish, school, or agency — regardless of when the abuse occurred — call the archdiocesan confidential report line at (913) 647-3051 or the <u>Victim Care Advocate</u> at (913) 298-9244

AFTER calling local law enforcement.
